

Welcome to Bli Bli United FC, Season 2019

Thank you for choosing to play soccer with Bli Bli United FC in season 2019.

For players who have paid fees online you don't need to do anything at this stage.

Any player that has not paid their fees will need to arrange for that, preferably at the sign on day at the club on 2 February (9am to 12pm). Credit card facilities will be available for cards with a chip.

Team Formation

Our registration committee will arrange all players into teams. This process can be sensitive and we try to accommodate players' wishes where we can. The preference is to keep teams from previous years together where possible.

Once teams have been compiled and coaching roles filled players will be contacted to organise training times.

Coach / Manager

Some teams will have coaches and managers already organised, while others will require a couple of parents to take on the role. The association (SCCSA) have some introduction coaching courses which provide an excellent background for new coaches or those looking to learn some new skills.

This year we have Team Coordinators for Rooball and Competitive teams on board who will provide all the assistance needed to get new coaches and managers up and running. They will be the first point of contact for any queries including equipment, match draws, training etc.

Coaches and Managers (and committee members) are exempt from paying the \$50 Family Levy.

Season

The first match of the year is on the 9th March and will be a round robin carnival for Rooballers (U6 to U10) and a grading game for competitive teams. A handy season calendar is available for collection from the club.

Referees

We are very fortunate to have 3 referees for almost every match in the competitive age groups (U11 and up) and 1 for the U09 & U10 rooball matches.

At the start of the season the referees hold an information session which is very important for coaches and managers to attend, but is also open to all players and parents. We encourage everyone to attend this very informative session. More information will be available shortly so please speak with the committee if you are interested in attending.

Playing Equipment

The club will supply all players with their playing jersey. Playing jerseys should be kept by the team manager and given to players at each match and returned after the match. You will need to purchase your own socks and shorts (available at the club) and shin pads (available at any sports store or department store). Teams in the competitive age groups are encouraged to purchase a training jersey for travel and training. These are available at the club for the subsidised price of \$10.

If you are looking for a set of boots the club has some second-hand pairs that we'd love to give away to new owners.

Volunteering

If you are a BBUFC family in 2019 it will be compulsory for you to cover an allotted home game shift of either field set up, canteen, BBQ, bathrooms or field pack up. You will receive a message informing you of your duty and time. You will be given plenty of notice for your shift so if you are unable to cover this shift YOU must find someone to cover for you whether it is an aunt/uncle, grandparents, family friends or another soccer family happy to swap. Please inform the Volunteer Roster Coordinator of any changes. The Coordinators details will be provided in your shift message.
